B. THE CONTRACT BUYER ELECTS TO MAKE THIS CONTRACT REVOCABLE. By signing below, the Contract Buyer acknowledges that this contract can be cancelled. The Contract Buyer can cancel this contract by delivering written notice to the Funeral Provider. Within 40 days after cancelling the contract, the Funeral Provider shall return to the Contract Buyer all trust principal and accumulated income.

IV DEFAULT: If the Contract Buyer defaults in the payment of premiums required under the life insurance and/or annuity contract, the Funeral Provider may terminate this contract upon receipt of notice from:

The Funeral Provider shall notify the Contract Buyer that this contract has been terminated through the United States Postal Service, first-class mail, postage prepaid, to the last known address of the Contract Buyer.

V. IF ADDITIONAL MONEY IS PAID BY CONTRACT BUYER: If the Contract Buyer is paying additional money over and above the value of this insurance policy or annuity, the Contract Buyer is allowed to select specific funeral goods and services. If the Contract Buyer wants to guarantee prices, the Contract Buyer should ask the Funeral Provider to set up a separate preneed contract that guarantees no price increase for the items selected. The Contract Buyer understands that this contract does not guarantee or "lock in" any funeral goods or services prices.

VI. NOTICE TO CONTRACT BUYER: The Contract Buyer should review this contract before signing it or paying money. The Contract Buyer can take this proposed contract and review it with a family member or legal advisor. The terms in this proposed contract cannot be changed or revoked by the Funeral Provider for five (5) business days.
