

RECIPROCITY AGREEMENT

CONCEALABLE HANDGUN PERMITS

This agreement is made by and between the State of South Carolina and the State of West Virginia by authority of the undersigned officials, to establish mutual recognition of the permits to carry concealed handguns issued by the signatory States:

WHEREAS, the laws of the signatory States each provide for recognition of such permits issued by other States through reciprocal agreement; and

WHEREAS, the laws of the State of West Virginia and the State of South Carolina each require an applicant for such permits to successfully pass a criminal background check and a course in firearm training and safety; and

WHEREAS, the signatory State officials herein agree to extend the privilege to carry concealed handguns in the respective States, this Agreement shall be effective on the dates affixed below; and

WHEREAS, the officials of both States agree to provide for twenty-four hour verification of the authenticity and status of their respective State's permits; and

WHEREAS, the signatories acknowledge the understanding that licensees of a reciprocal State carrying a firearm in the State of South Carolina or West Virginia must abide by the laws of South Carolina or West Virginia regarding the carrying of concealed handguns; and


WHEREAS, each of the signatories hereto agree to keep the other apprised of any statutory changes which might effect the continuing viability of this agreement; and

WHEREAS, this agreement is authorized by South Carolina Code Ann. Section 23-31-215(N), as amended (2008), and by West Virginia Code Article 7, Chapter 61.

This agreement is effective on the later date affixed.
