

RECIPROCITY AGREEMENT

This Reciprocity Agreement is made by and between the State of West Virginia, by and through West Virginia Attorney General Darrell V. McGraw, Jr. and the State of Arkansas through the Director of the Arkansas State Police Winford E. Phillips.

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Reciprocity Agreement is to extend reciprocal handgun carry permit/license privileges to the citizens of the State of West Virginia and the State of Arkansas, and

WHEREAS, both Arkansas State Police Director Winford Phillips and West Virginia Attorney General Darrell V. McGraw, Jr. are authorized to enter into this Reciprocity Agreement pursuant to the applicable statutes in each respective state, and

WHEREAS, in consideration of the matter described herein, and of the mutual benefits and obligations set forth in this Reciprocity Agreements, the Parties hereby agree and covenant as follows:

1. The State of Arkansas will recognize West Virginia license to carry concealed handguns by West Virginia resident license holders, twenty-one years of age or older, while said license holders are present in the State of Arkansas.
2. The State of West Virginia will recognize valid Arkansas licenses to carry concealed handguns by Arkansas resident license holders while said license holders are present in the State of West Virginia.
3. This Reciprocity Agreement applies only to the carrying of "handguns" by valid resident license holders from the respective states and not to any other type of weapons.
4. The State of West Virginia and the State of Arkansas will inform each other of any changes to their respective concealed weapons statutes that may affect the eligibility of the recognition granted by each state.
5. The State of West Virginia and the State of Arkansas will provide the other with copies of their current laws regarding concealed weapons and handgun carry licenses.

6. The State of West Virginia will provide twenty-four hour verification of the authenticity and status of the West Virginia permits/licenses.

7. The State of Arkansas will provide twenty-four hour verification of the authenticity and status of the Arkansas permits/licenses.(This is done through an Arkansas driver's license check)

8. This Reciprocity Agreement shall become effective on July 31, 2007.

WITNESSETH that each party to this Reciprocity Agreement has caused it to be executed on the date indicated below.

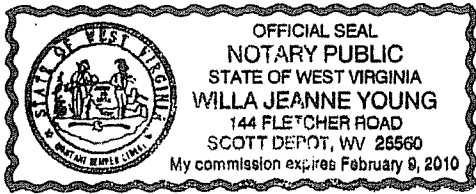

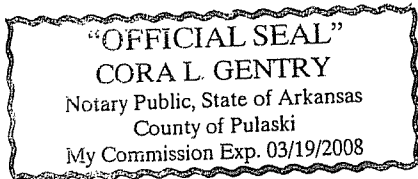
